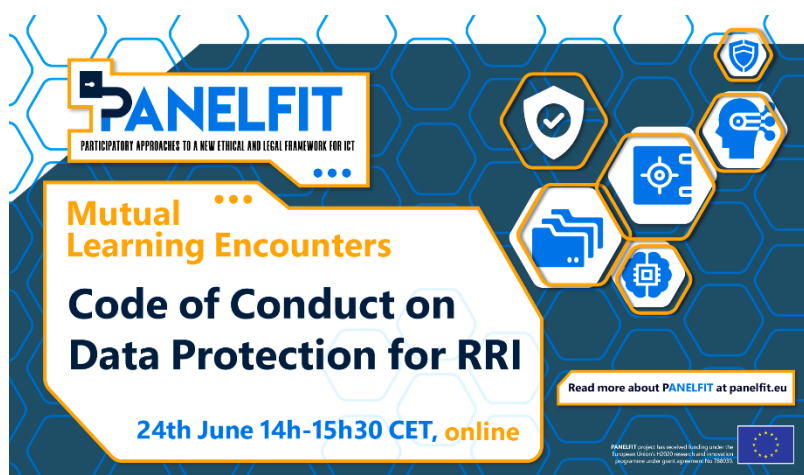
Join the Mutual Learning Encounter on the Code of Conduct on Data Protection for Responsible Research and Innovation and discuss with the authors and a community of researchers
